SkyPark Rider's Code of Conduct and Safety Information

SkyPark offers a range of trails for beginning riders through double black diamond experts. The more advanced trails (blues, blacks, and double blacks) can be demanding and rough on both your bike...and your body! Injuries are a common and expected part of the mountain biking experience, but there are things you can do to help prevent them and reduce their severity. Your safety and the safety of others is our highest priority. If you are new to the sport, or the parent and/or guardian of a younger rider, please familiarize yourself with our park, it's policies, and the activities that we offer. Introductory lessons and beginner terrain are available—and highly recommended! SkyPark's trails are a different kind of experience than riding a bike at home, or even cross country. They require constant physical and mental effort in order for a rider to maintain control. Ride within your ability and don't attempt more challenging terrain until you have the appropriate skills, experience, and equipment. Please read and follow the safety information below to help you get the most out of your day...

SkyPark reserves the right to revoke your riding privileges should you choose not to adhere to the following, or put someone else at risk.

Before you hit the trail...inspect your bike!

- Make sure that your bike is fully tuned, working as it should be with functioning brakes on both the front and rear wheels.
- Check both the front and rear wheel skewers (axles) and make sure they are tight. Levers should be facing the rear.
- Your tires should be in good condition—adequate tread, no cuts or tears in the sidewalls.
- Your suspension should be properly tuned, set up for your body weight and riding ability. A full suspension bike is recommended for the advanced (blue and black) trails.
- Inspect your frame for cracks, damage, and dents.
- There should be no looseness or play in your headset and stem.
- Handle bar and handgrips should be tight and unable to spin.
- Your seat and seat post should be fastened securely.
- If you have any questions at all, consult one of our certified bike techs—we're here to help!

Now that you're ready to ride...

- Helmets are mandatory. Make sure yours is in good shape and properly fitted. A full face mask offers the most protection.
- We highly recommend protective gear such as knee pads, elbow pads, body armor, neck brace, gloves and goggles. Mandatory for younger riders—a great idea for everyone else!

Once you're on the trail...

- Stay in control at all times. It is your responsibility to avoid other persons and objects around you. Always ride within your ability.
- Don't ever stop in the middle of the trail or where you are not visible from above. Pull over to the side and out of the way of the riders behind you should you need to stop for any reason. Stopping in the middle of a trail can result in serious injury—and even death.
- Whenever you enter a trail or start downhill—look uphill first and yield to other riders.
- If you are the uphill rider, it is your responsibility not to hit a rider below or in front of you.
- If you are involved in an accident or witness an accident, please assist if you are able. Notify the park staff by calling the number above. Identify your location by the nearest trail marker, attached to a tree. Do not leave the scene, especially if you are involved in a collision with injuries, until patrol has arrived and gathered the information needed. To do so is considered a felony hit and run in the state of California.
- Keep out of closed areas, and obey all signs, warnings, and directional markers.
- Stay on the marked trails. Do not cut switchbacks.
- Stay out of the bike park if you are impaired due to drugs or alcohol—legal or otherwise.
- Do not ride if you lack sufficient strength, dexterity and/or the ability to ride safely.
- Hiking in the bike park is not permitted.
- Do not feed, approach, or in any way, provoke the wildlife.
- Ride with a friend whenever it is possible.

KNOW THE CODE AND BE SAFETY CONSCIOUS. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY!

SkyPark at Santa's Village Rules and Regulations

Welcome to SkyPark at Santa's Village! We are glad that you are here, and in order to provide a safe and enjoyable experience for all of our guests, we ask that you please adhere to the following rules.

General Rules

- All persons entering the park, along with any bags, backpacks, clothing and/or other items are subject to a security screening and/or checks at the entrance to the park as well as within the boundaries of the park, including the campground area. Furthermore, we reserve the right to not allow any of the aforementioned articles into the park, and to deal with items left unattended in any way we deem necessary.
- For your safety and the safety of others, please do not run in the village area of the park, and please walk your bikes unless on a designated trail.
- Please show respect and courtesy to other park guests and SkyPark staff by refraining from profanity and not participating in illegal, unsafe, disruptive or offensive behavior.
- Proper attire, including shirts and activity appropriate footwear, must be worn at all times. Most activities will require close-toed shoes. We reserve the right to refuse admittance to anyone wearing attire that we would deem inappropriate and may take away from other guests' experience, or refuse admittance to an activity if not wearing the appropriate safety gear, including, but not limited to, helmets, gloves, shoes, etc. Clothing that is of multiple layers is subject to search for everyone's safety.
- All guests will be issued an identifiable wristband, that allows them to access the park and its' activities. Failure to obtain a wristband, or removing it may cause removal from the park. Wristbands are non-transferable, non-exchangeable, non-refundable, revocable and void if altered in any way, and must be used by the same person for the duration of its validity.
- Smoking and e-cigarettes (vaping), or any other products that produce a vapor or smoke, are not allowed anywhere within the boundaries of the park except for the designated smoking area. Due to the high fire danger in the San Bernardino mountains, there may be times when all smoking is strictly prohibited.
- Please supervise your children at all times. There is no age restrictions on the Meadowlands Bike Path (green-beginner level), but children must be accompanied by an adult. Must be 5 years of age or older to ride blue trails and must be 10 years of age or older to ride on any black level trail. It is highly recommended that children under the age of 15 riding or hiking any of the trails be accompanied by an adult or legal guardian (19 yrs. or older).
- Access to rides and activities is subject to the safety rules and regulations for that ride or activity.
- Any type of mask, bandanna, or helmet with a full face mask may not be worn while in the village area of the park. They may be worn while riding the trails, but must be removed when entering the village.
- Line jumping is strictly prohibited.

- When the park closes, it is the guest's responsibility to exit in a timely manner and comply with SkyPark staff requests. This includes the park boundaries and parking lot.
- In addition, it is an expectation of SkyPark that all park guests will abide by and follow all local and state laws and regulations. Failure to do so may result in expulsion from the park and possible legal action.

Prohibited Items

The following items are not allowed to be brought into SkyPark under any circumstances:

- Alcoholic beverages or any illegal substances.
- Recreational devices, including but not limited to, drones, skateboards, scooters, shoes with built-in skates, remote controlled toys, hoverboards, etc. Guests are allowed to bring in their own bicycles and fishing equipment, including appropriate safety gear.
- Weapons of any kind including any object or toy that appears to be a weapon (squirt guns, toy blasters, etc.) Guests with a license to carry a concealed pistol, revolver or other firearm within the state of California (CCW) must leave it appropriately secured in their vehicle, including at the campground.
- Mobility devices with less than three wheels that cannot maintain balance or stability when stopped, unoccupied or unpowered.
- Glass containers. The exception would be small jars of baby food.
- Pets, except for approved service animals. They must be on a leash or under the control of their owner at all times, and may not be allowed to ride or participate in certain attractions, due to the nature of the activity. It is the owners responsibility to clean up after their service animal.
- Any other items that may be deemed harmful, disruptive, or inappropriate.

Prohibited Activities

SkyPark does not allow the following activities within the boundaries of the park, including the campground area:

- Distribution or sale of any printed or recorded materials.
- Photography, videotaping, or recording of any kind for commercial purposes.
- Selling any goods or services, or displaying any goods or services for sale, with the exception of licensed vendors who are contracted with the park.
- Feeding, catching, harming and/or removing any of the wildlife or natural objects, such as plants, pine cones, etc., within or around the park, including the campground area.
- Removal of any 'artifacts'—Native American or otherwise—that may be found on the property.

- Straying off the marked trails, either on foot or bike. Our desire is to reduce our environmental footprint and have a minimal impact on our protected ecologically sensitive areas. You can help us achieve this by simply staying on the marked trails!
- Unauthorized events, demonstrations, or speeches, or displaying any flag, sign, or banner for commercial purposes. Inciting a crowd is strictly prohibited.
- Hindering the experience of other guests in any manner whatsoever, including, but not limited to, posing as a staff member of SkyPark.
- Engaging in any activity deemed unsafe, or failing to abide by the safety rules of said activity, including, but not limited to, riding in a reckless manner with disregard for one's personal safety as well as the safety of others, disregarding specific safety guidelines for activities, etc.

SkyPark Rights

- SkyPark reserves the right to photograph, film, videotape, or reproduce the image and/or voice of any person who enters the park and use the same for any purpose without any reimbursement in any form to any person.
- SkyPark reserves the right to deny admission, or to request a person to leave the park after already having been admitted, if it is deemed necessary, without any refund, liability or compensation.
- SkyPark reserves the right, periodically, to change the hours of operation, to suspend operations, to change the hours of any ride or attraction, to close the park or any part of it temporarily, to restrict the number of persons having access to the park, to suspend or cancel any activity, attraction, event or entertainment program without prior notification and without refund, liability or compensation, if deemed necessary or required by the circumstances, i.e., weather events, natural disasters, etc.
- All of the above rules and regulations for SkyPark are subject to change without notice.

Any violation of any of the above rules may result in a verbal warning, pass revocation, limited access, expulsion from the park, long term ban from the park, including, but not limited too, possible legal action. It is the exclusive right of SkyPark to exercise any of the above punitive actions as they see fit depending upon the severity of the offense or past practices, on a case by case basis.
